- Friday, the hotel offers a soup and salad bar option for us to save time, due to the busy schedule. (11am – 2 pm) The cost is \$9 per person plus tax/tip, etc. We'll be taking a poll to see how many will be taking advantage of this option.

transport it home. Watch for an email from Cathie Brenner soliciting baskets and please reply promptly.

- We will have a room reserved for Saturday evening after the banquet and show to celebrate and welcome our newest chorus, Coastal Voices, and to enjoy a little down time at the end of the weekend. Bring your own snacks and drinks.
